



APEX EXPEDITIONS: TERMINAL EDUCATION

Lauterbrunnen Expedition

\$2,450/person

TO APPLY, JUMPER MUST HAVE:

- Completed a First BASE Jump Course with Apex BASE or another reputable FJC program
- Logged at least 250 skydives and 15 BASE jumps
- Completed the Pre-Europe Advanced Course with Apex BASE (or another reputable program). Apex BASE offers the PEAC at the Perrine Bridge each spring, allowing us to evaluate your current progress in BASE (and will give you the minimum jump numbers, if that's an issue)
- Completed previous expedition to Brento, Kjerag, or similar experience proving competency for Lauterbrunnen Expedition
- Valid skydiving license
- At least one BASE rig (rentals may be available in advance from Apex BASE)
- Helmet, knee pads, & hiking boots (without hooks)
- 46", 42", 38", & 36" Pilot chutes
- Ability to pack BASE rig for yourself, unsupervised
- Tracking suit - Classic tracking suits only (minimum 25 skydives required on the tracking suit you will jump)
- To jump a performance suit, required 50 "big wall" tracking jumps with a classic suit and a minimum of 25 skydives on the performance suit you will jump on the expedition
- Mobile phone that will work in Switzerland
- Travel & medical insurance

Additional recommendations (more prepared, more fun):

- First-aid knowledge
- Climbing & hiking experience
- Rigging kit (rip-stop, rubber bands, etc)
- Collapsible water bottle
- Rain jacket & warm thin layers of clothes

Minimum 2 clients, Maximum 5 clients

WHAT'S INCLUDED:

- 9-day trip, 7 jump days (dependent on weather, skill, desire, and access)
- Pre-Course materials, guidance, and support
- Small group sizes (max 5:1 client/coach ratio)
- Exit, freefall, and canopy flight pre-brief
- Video debrief of each jump (tailored to suit individual needs/goals)
- 20-25 jumps (depending on weather & packing speed)
- Course videos & photos

CLIENT IS RESPONSIBLE FOR:

- Airfare & Transportation to/from jumping location (Lauterbrunnen)
- Accommodation
- Train/Rail pass in Lauterbrunnen (appx. CHF 70, valid 1 month)
- Swiss BASE Association Landing Card (CHF 40, valid 1 year) - required
- Rega (Swiss Heli rescue insurance CHF 30/year) - required
- Swiss 3rd party insurance (CHF 45/3 months or CHF 75/year) - required
- Food & drinks

ITINERARY (TRIP LENGTH 9 DAYS):

Day 1

- Arrival Day
- Check into accommodations
- Pick up SBA Landing Card, Train/Rail Pass, & Swiss 3rd party insurance
- Safety Briefing

Days 2-8

- Up to three jumps per day from a variety of exits

Day 9

- Check out of accommodations
- Departure Day

DEPOSIT, CANCELLATION & REFUND POLICY

- Deposit required to secure a slot: 25% of total expedition price (includes \$150 non-refundable administrative fee). Remaining balance (75%) must be paid no later than 90 days before departure.
- Cancellation more than 90 Days before departure equals 100% refund of deposit (less the \$150 non-refundable administrative fee).
- Cancellation from 90 to 60 Days before departure equals 50% refund of deposit (less the \$150 non-refundable administrative fee).
 - Expeditions require 2 clients to occur, therefore no refund for cancellations within 60 Days of departure.
 - Deadline for transferring a deposit between two trips is 90 days from departure of the first trip.
- Non-payment of remaining balance by required deadline is subject to cancellation based on the above timetable.
